# STAKEHOLDER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

---

Santa Clarita Valley Groundwater Sustainability Agency (SCV-GSA) is seeking qualified candidates for a Stakeholder Advisory Committee that will provide the GSA with insight, support and expertise on various social, cultural and economic issues impacting groundwater management in the Santa Clarita Valley. This Stakeholder Advisory Committee will be formed to represent residential, business and environmental interests.

The Committee will review workshop information and collateral, consider various Groundwater Sustainability Plan components and make recommendations that will be considered by the SCV-GSA Board of Directors and staff. Feedback from the Stakeholder Advisory Committee will play an important role in helping SCV-GSA develop a fair and equitable Groundwater Sustainability Management Plan.

SCV-GSA is seeking representatives for each impacted stakeholder group. All applicants must have a direct connection to the stakeholder group they are representing. For example, any pumper must pump from within the Santa Clarita Valley Groundwater Basin, an environmental representative must be a member of an environmental group serving the Santa Clarita Valley, and a business community representative must own a business within the impacted area. At-Large members must be water customers within the Santa Clarita Valley Groundwater Basin. An applicant to the committee may only apply to represent a single stakeholder group. We are seeking representatives for the following groups:

- 1 representative of small pumpers (Up to 2 acre-feet or less per year)
- 1 representative of medium pumpers (Greater than 2 to 25 acre-feet per year)
- 1 representative of large pumpers (more than 25 acre-feet per year)
- 1 representative of the business community
- 1 representative of environmental interests
- 2 members-at-large

## **Timeline**

**October 18, 2019:** Applications Due

**October 18 – October 31, 2019:** Self-selection Process: One meeting will be held for each applicant group. At that meeting, applicants will vote for a single representative.

**Early Nov. 2019:** Board officially seats Stakeholder Advisory Group

**February 2020:** First Committee Meeting

**June 2022:** Term Ends

*Subject to the Brown Act, all Stakeholder Advisory Committee meetings will be open to the public. SCV Water employees, consultants and/or elected officials are prohibited from applying.*
