State's SGM Grant

- One grant application per basin
- Minimum request \$1M, no match required (points for 5% match)

Local Considerations

- Considered several project ideas
- Many are just not developed enough for a late November application deadline
- Others are ready or can be ready

Project Ideas

- Nine Ideas Considered
- Three Ideas Recommended
 - Include certain GSP Implementation costs regarding data gaps in the grant application ~\$200,000
 - Include additional scope for filling data gaps regarding private wells.~\$75,000
 - Include additional scope for a well siting study, and deep Saugus Aquifer Monitoring Wells.~\$5M

Financial Considerations

- GSA Budget includes \$20,000 for preparation of a grant application
- Some modest additional costs will be incurred for developing scope, schedule, budget for deep wells
- Estimate a minimum grant request of \$5.3M with a 5% match (\$265,000)
- If awarded, the SCV GSA workplan and budget would be amended to include new scope and estimated reimbursements.

Recommendations

- Adopt the resolution attached with the Board memo to authorize SCV Water's General Manager to apply for a SGM Grant on behalf of the SCV-GSA identifying SCV Water as the Agency responsible for local cost share, and to execute an agreement with the Department of Water Resources for a SGM Grant.
